1. About University

Central Tribal University of Andhra Pradesh is inviting applications for admission to PhD programmes in various Departments for the Academic year 2026-27. Central Tribal University of Andhra Pradesh is a reputed Central University located in Vizianagaram, Andhra Pradesh. Central Tribal University of A.P., Vizianagaram, was established in 2019. The University's jurisdiction extends to the entire State of A.P., and the Central Government fully funds its expenses through the University Grants Commission. 5. Eligibility Criteria for PhD. Admission

Eligibility for PhD admission will strictly adhere to the UGC (Minimum standards and procedure for award of PhD degree) regulation, 2022, and the CTUAP PhD regulation, 2024.

As per UGC PhD regulations, 2022, the eligibility for admission to PhD will be as follows:

The candidates who have completed a 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale, wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

6. Duration of the PhD Programme

1. The PhD programme shall be for a minimum duration of three (3) years, including course-work, and a maximum duration of six (6) years from the date of admission to the PhD programme.
2. If a candidate fails to submit the thesis at the end of the stipulated period (3 years), the DRC may grant an extension of up to two years (one year at a time) for the PhD students for the submission of the thesis, as per the recommendation of the concerned RAC.
3. If a candidate fails to submit the thesis within the extended period (i.e., 3years + 2 year(s) = 5 Years) due to cogent reasons, s/he may be given additional one year of extension for submitting the thesis, by the approval of RDCU upon recommendation from concerned DRC, on the request of concerned RAC, such that the total period for the submission of the thesis counted from the date of their admission does not exceed six years. No further extension shall be given under any circumstances.
4. After the expiry of a six-year period, the candidate has to re-register himself/herself, for which the candidate shall apply giving the reasons due to which s/he could not submit the thesis and her / his application is duly forwarded and recommended by the concerned RAC and the DRC. The candidate has to seek re-registration before the last date of regular duration. If no re-registration is sought by the candidate, then the admission is deemed to be cancelled by the end of 6 years.
5. A maximum of an additional two (2) years can be given through a process of re-registration; provided, however, that the total period for completion of a PhD programme shall not exceed eight (8) years.
6. However, women candidates and Persons with disabilities (with more than 40% disability) may be allowed a relaxation of two years in the maximum duration (i.e., 8 years). The total period for completion of a PhD programme in such cases should not exceed ten (10) years.

7. Procedure for PhD admission

The University Grants Commission (UGC), vide its notification dated March 27 2024, has decided that from the Academic Session 2024-25 onwards, the score of the National Eligibility Test (NET) can be used for admission to PhD programmes in place of entrance tests conducted by different universities and higher education institutions (HEIs). Accordingly, Central Tribal University of Andhra Pradesh has decided to use National Eligibility Test (NET) or similar national-level examination scores for admission to PhD programmes from the academic session 2026-27, except for the cases mentioned in Sl. No. VI. Based on the scores obtained in NET or similar national-level examinations, the candidates will be eligible in three categories (As per the notification of UGC dated March 27 2024):

- I. Candidates who have qualified for fellowship/scholarship in national-level examinations such as UGC-CSIR NET JRF (Category 1), ICAR-NET (JRF), or other equivalent national-level JRF/SRF, shall be considered for PhD admission strictly as per the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of PhD Degree) Regulations, 2022. Under these provisions, 100% weightage shall be given to the performance in the said national-level examination, subject to the validity period specified in the JRF Award Letter.
- II. For candidates qualifying under Category 2 and Category 3 through examinations such as UGC-NET, CSIR-NET, ICAR-NET, or similar examinations, 70% weightage shall be assigned to the normalized examination score, and 30% weightage shall be assigned to the interview/viva voce. The combined merit for admission shall be determined accordingly. The calculation of scores for each category shall be as follows:

Note: Only scores of June 2025, December 2025, and June 2026 cycles of UGC/CSIR NET examination will be considered for eligibility in PhD. Programs for the academic session 2026-2027. NET percentiles or scores from previous cycles shall NOT be considered.

- III. The entrance Test will be conducted for admission to the PhD programme. Students may be admitted through an Entrance Test conducted by CTUAP. The Entrance Test syllabus shall consist of 50% research methodology and 50% subject-specific content. Students who have secured 50 % marks in the entrance test are eligible to be called for the interview. A relaxation of 5 % marks will be allowed in the entrance examination for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/differently-abled category and Economically Weaker Section (EWS), as per the decision of the Commission from time to time. The number of eligible students to be called for an interview shall be determined by the number of PhD seats available. vi. Provided that for the selection of candidates based on the entrance test conducted by the University, a weightage of 70 % for the entrance test and 30 % for the performance in the interview shall be given.
- IV. The marks obtained in the National Level Qualified Examination (such as UGC-NET, CSIR-NET, ICAR-NET, or any other equivalent examination) by candidates under Categories 2 and 3 shall be valid only for a period of one (1) year from the date of issuance of the certificate for admission to the PhD programme at Central Tribal University of Andhra Pradesh.

- V. The scores obtained in the NET or equivalent national-level examinations issued before one year from the date of notification shall not be considered valid for admission to the PhD programme at the Central Tribal University of Andhra Pradesh for the academic session 2026–27 under Categories 2 and 3. However, in the case of Category 1 candidates, the validity of the Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) shall be governed strictly by the terms and conditions specified in the respective JRF Award Letter, and such validity shall be deemed acceptable provided it remains in force as on the date of admission.
- VI. Candidates who have qualified for fellowship/scholarship under any recognized national-level examination conducted by agencies such as UGC, CSIR, ICAR, DBT ICMR, NBHM or any other equivalent national agency, including fellowships awarded by statutory bodies such as the National Commission for Scheduled Castes (NCSC), National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST), National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), National Commission for Women (NCW), and the National Commission for Persons with Disabilities (NCPD), shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme at the Central Tribal University of Andhra Pradesh, provided that the fellowship remains valid as per the terms and conditions stipulated in the respective award letters. The validity of JRF/SRF shall remain effective up to the date of admission. In the event the JRF/SRF expires before the admission date, the candidature shall be automatically cancelled, and the candidate shall not be eligible for admission under Category 1.

8. Reservation and Relaxation Policy

a) Unreserved (UR) seats

- The UR merit list will include every eligible candidate in order of merit.
- SC, ST, OBC, NCL, and EWS applicants who meet UR eligibility criteria will appear on the UR list and may compete for UR seats.
- No one will be excluded from the UR list or from consideration for a UR seat because they belong to a reserved category.
- Admissions to UR seats are strictly merit-based.

b) Reservation — SC/ST

- SC/ST reserved seats are open to candidates who have passed the qualifying exam and meet the university Ph.D. eligibility requirements.
- Applicants must submit a self attested SC/ST certificate in the Government of India format; the certificate will be verified.
- Certificates must be issued by a competent authority.
- The caste/tribe must appear in the Government of India schedule, and the certificate must state: caste/tribe name, SC or ST status, district and state/UT of usual residence, and the applicable Government of India schedule.

c) Reservation — OBC (NCL)

- OBC (NCL) reserved seats are open to candidates who have passed the qualifying exam and meet the University's PhD eligibility criteria.
- Applicants must submit a self attested OBC (NCL) certificate in the Government of India format; the certificate will be verified.
- The certificate must be issued in the candidate's name by a competent authority after March 31, 2026.
- The applicant's caste must be listed in the Central List of Other Backwards Classes.

d) Reservation — EWS

- EWS reserved seats are open to candidates who have passed the qualifying exam and meet the university Ph.D. eligibility requirements.
- Applicants must submit a self attested EWS certificate; the certificate will be verified.
- The certificate must be issued in the candidate's name by a competent authority after March 31, 2026.

e) Reservation — Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD)

- Five per cent (5%) of seats are reserved horizontally for Persons with benchmark disabilities.
- Applicants must submit a self attested Disability Certificate from the District CMO, Civil Surgeon, or Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution using the prescribed proforma.
- In the event of a dispute, the candidate must appear before the Medical Board; the Board's decision is final.

f) Competent authorities and general rule

- Certificates (SC/ST/OBC NCL/EWS) must be issued by one of the competent authorities listed in the Government of India guidelines (e.g., District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner, Tehsildar, etc.).
- Applicants must provide a valid certificate in the GoI prescribed format.
- Extensions to submit category certificates will not be permitted.

9. General instructions

1. The syllabus for the entrance examinations shall be made available on the website, department-wise.
2. The University reserves the right not to offer the programme in any particular discipline due to administrative reasons or if the response to the programme is inadequate. The decision of the University will be final in this regard.
3. Reservation/relaxation will be given as per the Government of India/University Rules adopted by the University from time to time.
4. Ensuring the eligibility for applying to a particular programme will be the sole responsibility of the candidate. Please read the eligibility criteria and other requirements before submitting the application form. Submission of the online registration form and attending the Exam/interview are mandatory for admission to the PhD programme.
5. These instructions are subject to alterations & modifications, and the same will be notified on the University website. These instructions are for information only, and they do not constitute a legal document. Candidates are advised to visit the university website regularly for further information and instructions.
6. Mere appearance in the entrance examination does not entitle a candidate for admission to any programme in this University. They will be granted admission only if they fulfil the eligibility criteria fixed for the programmes.
7. Even if a candidate is placed in the admission list based on their performance in the entrance test, they will not be granted admission if they do not meet the eligibility criteria.
8. Admission granted will be cancelled at any time if it is found that the information or document/s furnished by the candidate is false or incorrect or if, at a later stage, it is found that the candidate does not fulfil the eligibility criteria prescribed for the programme.

9. Individual entrance test marks, rank and the list of selected/waitlisted candidates will be published on the University website along with the admission schedule/ instructions. No individual admission intimation will be sent to the selected/ waitlisted candidates. Hence, the applicants are advised to check the University website regularly for updates on admissions.
10. The eligibility of candidates will be verified by the Admission Committee or the concerned Department based on documents uploaded during the application process. If any document is found unsatisfactory during verification, the candidate's application will be cancelled.
11. Eligible candidates must appear for an offline interview on the notified date and time. Any requests for an online interview will not be entertained.
12. Candidates who fail to appear for the interview will not be considered for PhD admission.
13. Failure to deposit the academic fee within the stipulated time frame will result in cancellation of the admission offer, and the next candidate on the waitlist, in order of merit, will be offered provisional admission.
