The essential qualifications for the said positions shall be as prescribed under the UGC Regulations, 2018, and subsequent amendments issued from time to time. The engagement shall be purely on a temporary basis for the current academic semester, which may be extended further, if required, based on the academic requirements of the University and satisfactory performance of the candidate. Eligible candidates are required to submit their detailed Curriculum Vitae (CV) through email on or before 30 September 2026. The engagement of Guest Faculty shall be through Walk-in-Interview.

Science	Eligibility (A or B) : A. i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/ relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university. ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET: Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions: -

		a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode; b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners; c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted; d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal; e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/ supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency. <i>The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned. Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.</i> OR B. The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).
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Emoluments: As per current University norms, Guest Faculty will be paid an honorarium of Rs.1500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs. 50,000/- per month vide UGC guidelines No.F.25-1/2018(PS/MISC.) dated 28.01.2019. Also, as per F&A rules, 10% or 20%, respectively for those with and without PAN, may be deducted towards income tax, unless a certificate of exemption from a competent authority is submitted.

- Applicants are requested to bring the copies of the educational qualifications i.e. marksheets, degree, NET certificate, experience certificate, latest caste/EWS certificate etc. along with the CV and two recent passport size photographs.**
- Applicants are also requested to carry original document/certificate for verifications before the walk-in-interview.**
- Qualifications and other conditions applicable are subject to UGC regulations 2018, as amended from time to time.
- The eligibility of the candidates will be determined on the basis of qualifications/ experience/publications etc. acquired by them upto the last date fixed for receipt of applications.

7. The University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate(s) at any stage in the process of selection in case any inadvertent mistake is detected even after issue of appointment letter.
8. The University shall verify the antecedents or documents submitted by a candidate at any time of appointment as Guest Faculty. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted by the candidates are fake or the candidate has undesirable/ clandestine antecedents and has suppressed any information, then his/her service shall be terminated.

10. An undertaking to be given by the candidate mentioning that 'the publications submitted by them are free from any plagiarism and if any plagiarism is found later, their candidature/selection shall stand rejected/cancelled'.

12. Guest Faculty will not be treated like regular teachers for the purpose of voting rights or for becoming the members of the various statutory bodies of the University.
13. The Guest Faculty will not be given the benefit of allowances, pension, gratuity and leave etc. as admissible to the regular teachers.
14. No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates who are appearing for the walk-in-interview.
